Inquiry-based tours encourage PK-12 students of all abilities to engage with art and each other by looking deeply, and thinking critically and creatively. Students make personal and curricular connections through discussion, writing, and hands-on activities. Guided tours are available Tuesdays through Fridays, 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM.\* Hands-on activities are provided upon request, including Art + Writing, Object Studies, Sketching in the Galleries, Gallery Games and Art Lab Activities.
